### FORESTS & FIBER

**100%** OF THE VIRGIN FIBER USED IN KCP TISSUE PRODUCTS GLOBALLY COMES FROM CERTIFIED SUSTAINABLE SOURCES WITH **50%** OF IT BEING FSC-CERTIFIED



IN 2017 **73%** OF THE FIBER USED FOR KCP'S TISSUE PRODUCTS WAS FROM RECYCLED SOURCES. THAT'S OVER **450,000 TONS** OF PAPER THAT FOUND NEW LIFE IN OUR PRODUCTS!



### WASTE & RECYCLING

WE DIVERTED OVER **94%** OF TOTAL WASTE FROM LANDFILL AT OUR KCP MANUFACTURING SITES GLOBALLY IN 2017

THE RIGHTCYCLE PROGRAM HAS DIVERTED MORE THAN **500 TONS** SINCE 2011 AND HELPED GROW OUR NEW CUSTOMER BASE BY **30%** IN 2017

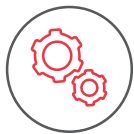


### ENERGY & CLIMATE

WE AGREED TO PURCHASE **~1 MILLION MWH** OF ELECTRICITY FROM TWO NEW WIND FARMS. THE RENEWABLE ENERGY SUPPLIED WILL BE EQUIVALENT TO ABOUT **1/3** OF THE ELECTRICITY NEEDS OF KIMBERLY-CLARK'S NORTH AMERICAN OPERATIONS



SINCE 2015, KCP GLOBAL PRODUCTION SITES HAVE REDUCED GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS BY **NEARLY 10%** THROUGH ENERGY CONSERVATION



### SUPPLY CHAIN

IN 2017, KCP COLLABORATED WITH SUPPLY CHAIN PARTNERS TO REMOVE **90%** OF THE HIGH PRIORITY RESTRICTED CHEMICALS FROM OUR SKIN CARE PRODUCTS GLOBALLY
